Application Instructions:

Complete the following scholarship application by typing or use a PC to replicate the application form. Application criteria are weighted as indicated in parenthesis.

1. Prepare a typed 200-250 word essay outlining your career goals and the purpose for applying for the scholarship. Age, gender, race religion, national origin or financial need are not conditions of eligibility for any of the awards. (30%)
2. Provide a summary of your work experience, especially as related to the commercial meat industry, university meat lab employment and other food processing related work experiences. (30%)
3. Provide a list of university awards and honors received. (5%)
4. Provide a list of extracurricular activities that demonstrate intellectual growth, breadth of interests, talents and leadership qualities. (5%)
5. Include 2 letters of recommendation signed by faculty members and one letter from an industry representative familiar with your activities outside the university setting. The letter does not need to come from someone directly in the meat processing industry, but should be in a closely related field (e.g. live animal production, marketing). (10%)

6. Enclose official transcript copies of all university work. Highlight your cumulative GPA. Scholastics- must have a grade point average of at least 2.75 on a four-point scale. If cumulative GPA is not automatically printed on the transcript, please self-calculate and have your department chair initial. (20%)

1. A copy of your transcripts of ALL college or university work completed to date. A typewritten summary of proposed courses you expect to take to complete your undergraduate curriculum.
2. A statement (essay) of career goals relative to the meat/poultry processing industry.
3. Two letters of recommendation signed by faculty members familiar with your work. These letters should include a general appraisal of the applicant's scholarship, extracurricular activities and character in relation to the purposes and eligibility requirements of the scholarship.
4. One letter of recommendation from an industry representative familiar with your activities outside the university setting. This letter does not need to come from someone directly in the meat processing industry, but they should be in a closely related field (e.g. livestock production, marketing)

5. List of University/College awards and honors.

6. List of extracurricular activities that demonstrate intellectual growth, breadth of interests, talents and leadership qualities.
